RESEARCH INTERESTS

My research focuses on stability and variability of subjective well-being. I am particularly interested in how people adapt to single and repeated life events over time. I examine this question by analyzing large-scale panel data sets such as the German Socio-Economic Panel (SOEP) and the British Household Panel Study (BHPS) with advanced statistical methods, e.g. structural equation models, hierarchical linear models and latent class models.
