Research Design

- Case-Study: Project "Campus Rütli" in Berlin
- Data Base: 15 semi-structured interviews with key actors
- Data Analysis (Meuser/Nagel): Description of how the extended notion of education is being put into practice
- Analysis of the influence of interurban competition: Theoretical Reconstruction based on literature (Harvey 1989; Peck 2014).
